My name is Becky Wright, recording artist and singer/songwriter, but also a proud mom of nine children. I'm very excited to share with you a life-changing endeavor to help thousands of "legal orphans" here in the USA to find "forever families" through adoption. I would appreciate your consideration of being an official Tour Sponsor for the vast door of opportunity that has recently opened up. My music and life's passion is more than mere entertainment, but is helping kids and families across the country. Now, I'm asking you to join this life-changing endeavor to help thousands of "legal orphans" here in the USA to find "forever families" through adoption. As a sponsor, you will boost the efforts already in place to find permanent, adoptive homes for approximately 129,000 children in the USA and 30,000 in Canada, who are still waiting.

As a Singer/Songwriter and keynote speaker at adoption and foster care events nationwide, and as an adoptive mother myself, I am more determined than ever to raise awareness for these children, and help spread the mutual joy and blessing of being a foster and/or adoptive parent with thousands who have not heard. Just last week, I was invited to join a 98-City Tour at Borders Bookstores, with Diana Joy, author of "[Through the Eyes of an Unseen Child](#)", and founder of the Unseen Child Foundation. Joining us on the tour is Susie McEntire Luchsinger, country gospel singer and younger sister of Reba McEntire. Diana Joy learned of my adoption music and heart for children, and felt that I was a perfect match for her book-signing tour. The tour has just begun, and I returned from Nashville only yesterday, where Diana Joy and I held two events. We also met with some of my colleagues who are composing songs (with me) and the soundtrack for the upcoming movie and HBO documentary about Diana's life. Her story is truly incredible, and I am honored to join her on this mission to help abused and abandoned children. These tour dates span all fifty states, and are in addition to event dates for which I am already scheduled. (See the attached schedule.)

Statistics have proven the devastating effects of growing up without a permanent family (such as the teens who "age out" of foster care, never being adopted). It has created a wide-spread "ripple effect" upon our communities, including a much higher incidences (among foster children who never find a "forever family") of drug abuse, crime and incarceration, prostitution, mental illness, and homelessness. To never know the blessing of being "home"--- being accepted and unconditionally loved--- leaves a "legal orphan" without any hope.

The "Heart of Adoption Tour" (including the "Heart of Adoption" music CD, with three songs already playing on radio stations in over 100 countries) is endeavoring to change that situation—for as many foster children as possible. I collaborate and partner with other non-profit organizations such as the Dave Thomas Foundation for Adoption, Unseen Child Foundation, Heart Gallery USA, Oklahoma Dept. of Human Services, Adopt US Kids and others, accomplish this goal. **We also need your help.**

What difference is this concert tour making? Here are only a few comments we've received: "We were thrilled with the result when we had Becky Wright perform for our Blue Ribbon Heart Gallery event in May 2009. I witnessed an *unprecedented response* from the audience after hearing Becky sing and tell her family's story, with people inquiring about the children available for adoption. Our Vision is based upon the motto, “Every child deserves a loving, permanent family.” We understand that adoption creates families, and desire to see every child find their “forever family”, helping them to become productive members of society who will continue positively impacting future generations. The dynamics of our mission are:

- To provide quality public awareness and education to empower leaders of adoption and foster parenting, primarily in the United States, to encourage and equip more people to provide homes.
- To increase the return on each dollar invested towards building healthier families for all children.
- To increase the number of adoptive and foster families.
- To help provide post-adoption and foster care training, to help decrease the occurrence of adoption disruptions, as well as minimizing a child’s placement into multiple foster homes.
